

Office of Arms, July 24, 1823.

WHEREAS His Majesty has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto Theophilus Edward Lucas, of Rakenny, in the County of Cavan, Esq. His Royal Licence and Permission, that he and his Issue may take and use the Surname of Clements, in addition to and after that of Lucas; and also use and bear the Armorial Ensigns of Clements, in addition to and quartered with those of Lucas; provided that such His Majesty's Concession and Royal Declaration be first recorded, and the Arms duly exemplified in the Office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Authority to be void and of none effect: Now these are to certify and declare, that the same have been recorded and exemplified accordingly.
